Orientation:

Corner (No 1 Church Street): Hancock's shop

Next to Hancock's towards church (No 2 Church Street): Finlays

Let front room to National Provincial Bank

No 3 Church Street:

Edgar & Lily Bossingham & family ? – 1954

Peter and Betty Bossingham 1954-1961

Paid rent to Florence and Marmaduke Eyre

No hot water

Toilet installed in small bedroom about 1957/8

Back room had 12 bacon hooks in the ceiling and a flagstone floor

A lean-to kitchen (don't know when it was installed)

Larder had salting bench and 8 hooks

Sublet front room about 6 hrs every fortnight to Mr Davies, Optician from Glossop

Coal shed off back of Hancock's shop

Earth closet top of yard where another yard had a space for clothes lines

Front pavement curb raised about 1959/60 which helped when village was flooded.
